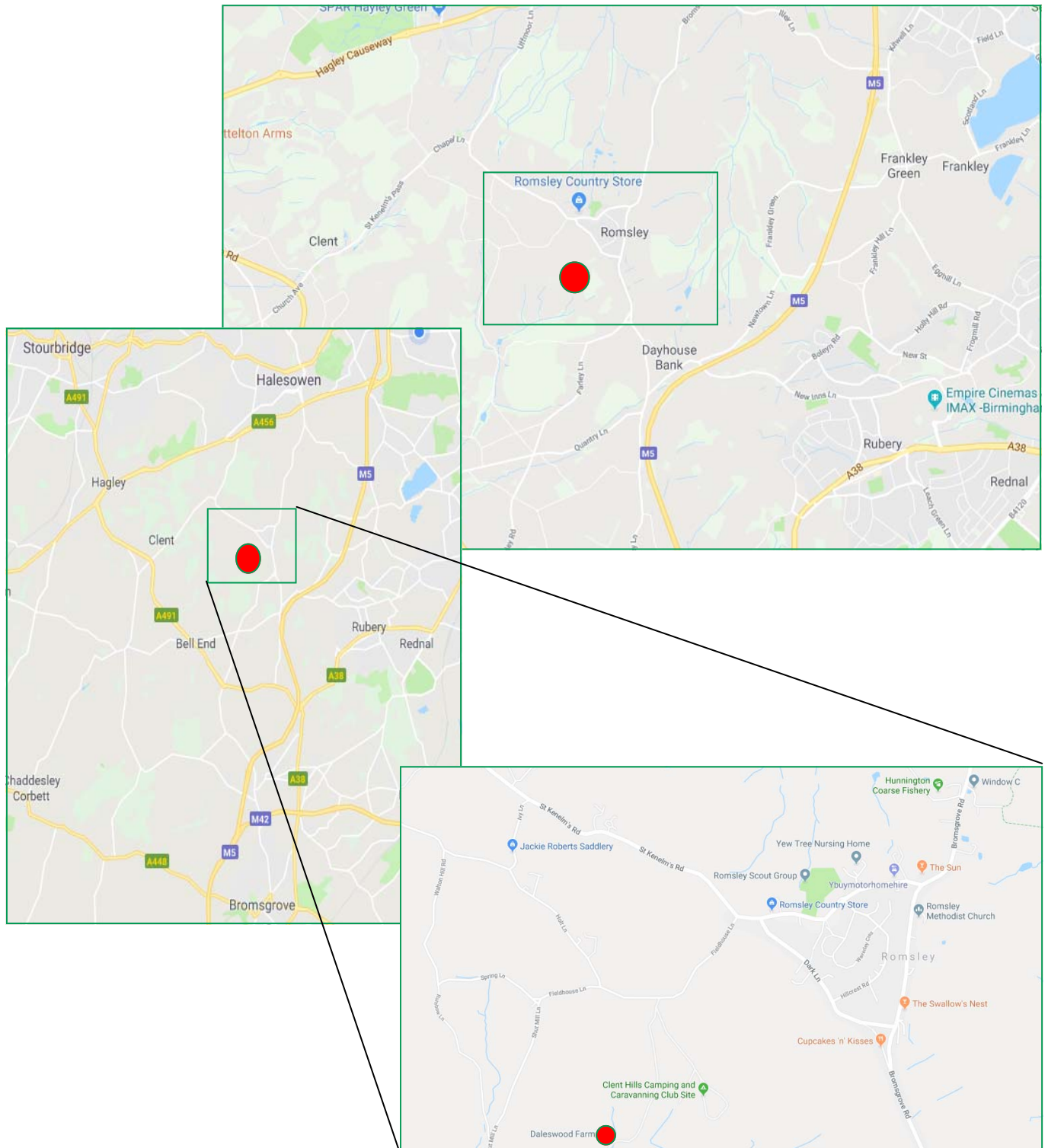

HEALTH & SAFETY

This event has been organised in accordance with Health & Safety legislation. Everything reasonably practical has been done to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending the event.

For these measures to be effective, everyone attending must conduct themselves in a manner, which does not put themselves or anyone else at risk.

Emergency vehicles must have access to the sites at all times and members of the public must not park so as to obstruct access.

RULES

- ◆ The event will be run under British Riding Club rules. (<http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>).
- ◆ The judge's decision is final.
- ◆ Classes will be split for juniors and seniors (juniors under 18 on 1st January 2019), where entries per class exceed six.
- ◆ Competitors may not walk the course when a class is underway. Tack and dress will be checked by the jumping steward.
- ◆ All riders and competitors MUST wear a hard hat to standard: PAS015 (1998 or 2011) & BSI kite mark, ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) & SEI mark, VGI 01.040 (2014-12) & BSI kite mark, SNELL E2001 & official SNELL label and number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) & SAI global mark. Hats only to standard EN1384 or BSEN1384, not bearing any of the above are NOT permitted. Skull caps must be worn with silk.
- ◆ Body protectors are recommended but optional (recommended standard BETA 3). Anyone wearing a body cage must report to the secretary before competing.
- ◆ Appropriate riding attire/correct footwear must be worn while mounted.
- ◆ Stop watches are not permitted.
- ◆ Photographs are taken at all BDRC events by our attending photography company, it is taken that permission has been given by attendees/parents/guardians for BDRC to use such material for publication/promotional purposes.
- ◆ All entries must be accompanied by the correct remittance.
- ◆ The show organisers do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, etc which may be sustained by persons, horses or ponies, vehicles or property, servants in connection with, or arising out of the event. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any such accident.
- ◆ The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, or amend any of the conditions as they think fit.
- ◆ No horse or pony under the age of four may compete and it is recommended that horses/ponies are up to date with their influenza vaccinations in line with the BRC Rule Book.
- ◆ Excessive use of whips and spurs will result in disqualification.
- ◆ The same horse/pony can only have one entry per Class with a maximum of three classes. Refusal of entry based on the condition of the horse/pony is at the discretion of the BDRC Committee.
- ◆ Emergency/Next of Kin information must be provided when booking a Class.
- ◆ The BDRC Committee strongly recommend that the First Aider present assesses a rider after a fall before they continue with the competition.
- ◆ Everyone must follow the instructions of the stewards and committee.
- ◆ Objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20.00 deposit within half an hour of any incident. No refunds will be given for withdrawals. In the case of bad weather a 50% refund will be given on receipt of an SAE, to be received within 7 days of the cancellation.

SCORING

Refusals, run-outs, circling and falls are only penalised if, in the opinion of the judge concerned, they are connected with the negotiation or attempted negotiation of one of the numbered obstacles.
