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| CLASS 1 | Diddy Jumps & Crosspoles Lead Rein & Assisted allowed - no fillers or spreads This class will be split Juniors and Seniors however, any Junior competing in Class 2 will be included in the Senior group. | Entry fees: Members: £9 per rider Non Members: £13 per rider |
| CLASS 2 | Up to 50 cm Assisted allowed. No hanging fillers and No spreads | |
| CLASS 3 | 60 cm Hanging fillers and No spreads | |
| CLASS 4 | 70cm May include fillers and some spreads | |
| CLASS 5 | 80cm May include fillers and some spreads | |

Rosettes awarded 1st to 10th Place

Classes will not be split Senior/Junior (except for Class 1).

Classes 2-5 will have 'Open' and 'Restricted' sections.

HEALTH & SAFETY

This event has been organised in accordance with Health & Safety legislation. Everything reasonably practical has been done to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending the event. For these measures to be effective, everyone attending must conduct themselves in a manner, which does not put themselves or anyone else at risk. Emergency vehicles must have access to the sites at all times and members of the public must not park so as to obstruct access.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The event will be based under British Riding Club rules. (<http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>). However as this event is not a qualifier the Club is able to run rules at their discretion. These rules also take into account Covid19 restrictions which can be located : www.bromsgroveridingclub.co.uk/covid19 **Please DO NOT attend if you have any Covid symptoms**

- The same horse/pony can only have a maximum of three classes, however rider/horse combinations can only compete in two classes.
- Class 1 will be split Seniors and Juniors, however, any Junior competing in Class 2 will be included in the Senior group for results.
- Classes 2 to 5 will be split into restricted and open sections, if you are competing in the class above, you will automatically be added into the open section for the class below.
- If you are winning the class on a regular basis we ask that you either move up a level or go HC.
- Competitors may **not** walk the course when a class is underway. Tack and dress will be checked by the jumping steward.
- All riders and competitors MUST wear a hard hat that comply with the current BRC guidelines. Skull caps must be worn with silk.
- Body protectors are recommended but optional. Anyone wearing a body cage must report to the secretary before competing.
- No horse or pony under the age of four may compete and it is recommended that horses/ponies are up to date with their influenza vaccinations in line with the BRC Rule Book.
- Any horse & rider combinations that are BS registered may only compete at their BS level or higher, and MUST be in the Open section of their BS level.
- All entries must be paid for two days after booking. Any entries where payment is not received when the times are released, will not be included.
- Emergency/Next of Kin information must be provided when booking a Class if travelling alone.
- The judge's decision is final.
- Objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a £20.00 deposit within half an hour of any incident. No refunds will be given for withdrawals. In the case of bad weather a 50% refund will be given on receipt of an SAE, to be received within 7 days of the cancellation.
- A fall will result in Elimination, however the BDRC Committee strongly recommend that the First Aider present assesses a rider after a fall.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry ,without giving reason ,or to send away from the show ground anyone using unreasonable behaviour.
- Refusal of entry based on the condition of the horse/pony is at the discretion of the BDRC Committee The organisers reserve the right to disqualify any animals, which in their opinion are unfit to compete and any competitor guilty of misconduct or not abiding by the rules.
- No refunds will be given for withdrawals unless accompanied by a Vet's certificate.
- The committee reserve the right to restrict or close entries in any class once an acceptable number of entries have been received.
- Appropriate riding attire/correct footwear must be worn while mounted.
- Stop watches are not permitted.
- Photographs are taken at BDRC events by our attending photography company, it is taken that permission has been given by attendees/parents/guardians for BDRC to use such material for publication/promotional purposes.
- The show organisers do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, etc which may be sustained by persons, horses or ponies, vehicles or property, servants in connection with, or arising out of the event. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any such accident.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, or amend any of the conditions as they think fit.
- Excessive use of whips and spurs will result in disqualification.
- Everyone must follow the instructions of the stewards and committee.
- Please note that where possible, the Committee will organise the classes in the best order for the riders.
- Please park sensibly and considerably on the car park.
- Do not leave your horse/pony unattended outside the lorry. **No hay is allowed on the car park.** Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Please leave the lorry park as you find it and take rubbish home with you where possible.
- Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from the edge of the arenas/horse lanes and avoid behaviour which might alarm the horses.
- No galloping/lunging on the show site.

PENALTIES:

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| • Starting before the official starters signal to start | 2 faults |
| • Knocking down a fence (including the wing) | 4 faults |
| • First disobedience - refusal, run-out or crossing of track | 4 faults |
| • Second disobedience - refusal, run-out or crossing of track | 8 faults |
| • Third disobedience - refusal, run-out or crossing of track | Elimination |
| • Fall of horse/pony or rider at a fence | Elimination |
| • Error of course not rectified (Jumping obstacles in the wrong order or retaking an obstacle already jumped) | Elimination |

All penalties are cumulative
